Criminology Profile in Social Science

About the Program:

If you have a taste for real-life or fictional crime stories and are intrigued by mystery, the Criminology Profile is a good fit for you. In this profile, you will explore the world of crime from a multidisciplinary perspective incorporating anthropology, history, psychology, and sociology. You will learn about criminal profiling, study notable crimes, and meet guest speakers from various fields, including homicide detectives, parole and correctional officers, youth protection workers, and recovering addicts. The Criminology Profile also provides a foundation for exploring crime scenes and solving criminal cases through skeletal analysis. Students will have the opportunity to participate in labs and investigate mock crime scenes.

Profile of Students:

This profile is designed for students who wish to pursue studies in Law or Criminology at the university level (note: this is not intended to be a pre-law program). Students may consider careers in law enforcement (such as working as correctional or parole officers, or in private policing), legal reform, and rehabilitation programs. They may also explore career opportunities in journalism, administrative and research positions within the criminal justice system, or work in policy setting and application within social and judicial agencies.

Students who complete this profile may apply to university programs in, Anthropology, Geography, History, Sociology, or Political Science.
