About the Program:

Digital Arts & New Media is one of two interconnecting Media profiles in the Arts, Literature and Communication program. This exciting pre-university program prepares students for a wide variety of university studies and careers. Through the program's dynamic mix of theory and practice students learn a variety of techniques in studio arts & digital arts and develop their understanding of visual culture.

Students Will Learn To:

Students will learn digital 2D design and 3D modelling along with the fundamentals of traditional artistic techniques. The courses are designed to develop communication skills and critical thinking through a variety of creative approaches that include drawing, assemblage, sculpture, digital imaging, animation, and 3D modelling. The practical courses are complemented by theoretical courses and general education courses, all which foster critical thinking and prepare students for future studies at university.

The Possibilities:

Graduates of Digital Arts and New Media are prepared for a wide variety of university programs including computation arts, animation, videogame studies, industrial design, art education, art history, and scenography.
